PURPOSE: The Hal Cohen Memorial Scholarship Fund (HCMSF) was established in January of 2018 to honor the memory of Hal Cohen, retired English teacher/supervisor. Over the course of his tenure with Egg Harbor Township High School, Mr. Cohen made a lasting impression upon generations of students. He instilled in them an appreciation of literature and the arts, challenged them to think critically and take risks, and inspired many to pursue careers in writing, theatre, or education.



MISSION: To continue Mr. Cohen's legacy by supporting prospective students of the humanities to fulfill their ambitions and make a positive impact on society.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARD: Recipients of the Hal Cohen Memorial Scholarship are selected through a comprehensive process. A \$1,500 award will be presented at the Egg Harbor Township High School Graduation Awards Ceremony in June.

CRITERIA:

- Applicant must be a graduating senior or recent graduate of Egg Harbor Twp High School.
- Applicant must have a minimum unweighted GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.
- Applicant must intend to pursue a career in the humanities.
- Applicant must be accepted as a full-time student at a college/university for fall semester.
- Applicant must complete and submit a Scholarship Application with essay by May 1, 2019
- Applicant must provide two letters of recommendation.

- Official high school transcript
- **Essay (250-500 words) "The Value of a Humanities Education in a 21st Century Society"**
- Two letters of recommendation (forms attached)
