You Can Make A Difference

- * Keep littler off our streets and beaches.
- * Ensure that only rain water travels to the storm drains.
- * Use a commercial car wash where water is directed to the water filtration plant.
- * Use natural fertilizer and pesticides on your garden and grass. Aerate your soil to minimize runoff, and never apply harmful chemicals when rain is forecasted.
- * Dispose of pet waste properly.
- * Immediately address and repair any car leakages from oil, brake fluid, or antifreeze.
