Dear OCHS Families:

As shared prior, Cape May County was designated a COVID 19 “High Risk or Orange” county last week. Because of this “Orange” designation and situation, we are compelled to take action that achieves two goals: 1) to maintain and continue in person instruction and 2) to reduce unstructured large group gatherings—eliminating lunch. This decision was made based on the increased amount of student and staff COVID cases and the associated close contact quarantines.

The **C cohort** in person days this Thursday, 12/03/20, and Friday, 12/04/20, will run on a modified schedule (please see below).

12:28 – Lunch pick-up will be available at the entrance of the media center prior to dismissal.

All eight periods will meet and classes will be 30 minutes. Although the lunch period is eliminated, students that choose to do so may pick up a bagged lunch in the entrance of media center prior to

leaving the building at dismissal. Student are not permitted to eat their lunch on the bus, we ask for cooperation on this matter.

Moving forward and beginning Monday, December 7th, we will transition to the Modified 6 Period Rotation Schedule. On Thursday, December 3rd, students and families will receive a correspondence containing the schedule and the details. In order to reduced potential confusion, this information is not included in this correspondence.

In closing, I understand that there may be some apprehension or uncertainty during this time of challenge. However, we will continue to assess and evaluate our program to provide a quality education to the students of OCHS. Together we understand that these circumstances are not long term and together we will be successful.
